The Role

The candidate will be responsible for working with the projects team in delivering the lighting control solution. Attending the client site to carry out system commissioning and programming as well as supporting system integration will be a key task, therefore all pre-site preparation work back at base must be completed in advance and under the guidance and management of the Projects Department.

Key Responsibilities

- Carrying out software programming tasks based on clients brief.

- Support other engineers with client approval documentation.
- Assist with design and building of lighting control systems.
- Pre-program lighting control systems in company workshop, with suitable training.
- Prepare site documentation such as site attendance/ training forms/ site reports.
- Attend client project sites to commission and program lighting control systems.
- Produce site specific operational manuals.
